Did You Know

The Ecclesiastical Province of Los Angeles is a Roman Catholic ecclesiastical province that comprises the central, central coast, and southern counties of the state of California. The Archbishop of Los Angeles serves as the metropolitan bishop of the suffragan dioceses within the Ecclesiastical Province of Los Angeles, which includes the dioceses of Fresno, Monterey, Orange, San Bernardino, and San Diego.

- The Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, is not observed, except on Sunday, as a holy day of obligation.
- When a solemnity falls on either a Saturday or a Monday, the precept to attend Mass is abrogated (obligation is canceled).
